## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Venous thromboembolism is the leading cause of preventable hospital death. Up to two million Americans suffer from DVT each year and approximately

300,000 deaths annually result from PE- more than breast cancer and AIDS combined. Over the last year significant attention has been brought to VTE with the Joint Commission and the National Quality Forum (NQF) endorsed standardized prophylaxis practices. In addition the U.S. Surgeon General issued a National Call-to-Action on the prevention of VTE. As such, it is the goal of the conference to provide up-to-date recommendation on the prophylaxis and treatment of VTE.
